Dear Mr. Cavanaugh:

According to the FEMA Digital Flood Insurance Rate Map (DFIRM) panel nos. 22047C0355D and 22047C0365D of Iberville Parish, Louisiana, effective November 6, 2013, the Claiborne Plantation property at the Iberville/Ascension Parish line on Louisiana Highway 405 is located in Flood Zone "X". In addition, according to the FEMA Effective DFIRM map provided on the LSU AgCenter website (http://maps.lsuagcenter.com), the site is located in Flood Zone "X". The LiDAR contours downloaded from LSU's ATLAS site indicate that the site ranges in elevation from 10 feet to 25 feet, however, the mean elevation of the developable property on the site is at elevation 20 feet.

No further action is needed to meet floodplain construction standards.


